2011 Santos-Centrals Junior Tour Report



The 44th Junior Tour of the Central Districts Cycling Club, again sponsored by Santos was run on Saturday July 16 and Sunday July 17.

The President of the Central Districts Cycling Club, Graeme Zucker has prepared the following report from a great weekend of Junior racing :

"The Central Districts Cycling Club in partnership with our major sponsor Santos and associated sponsors would like to congratulate all of the riders who competed in this year's Junior Cycling Tour conducted at Macclesfield south of Adelaide SA.

Stages 1 + 2 on Saturday saw some great racing with tight finishes in all categories and good tussles for points in the U17 Men + Women (KOM + QOM) competition especially up the famous Retort Hill. Stage prize money was awarded at the completion of each stage and the GC times were posted on Sunday morning and the Leaders and KOM / QOM jerseys were handed out to the respective riders.

Sunday morning saw some rain in the hills and it was a wet Stage 3 around the Stamps Road circuit which proved to be a very challenging stage for the riders with mixed results because it was now they had to make a stand for the next Time Trial Stage which would determine who would take home the honours of winning the 2011 Santos – Centrals Junior Cycling Tour.

With the Time Trial results now intact it was up to the Macclesfield Football Club for a relaxing time for the riders and parents awaiting the Presentation. After a brief talk to the audience we commenced to award the Stage 3 prize money and followed by the Stage 4 prize money. Santos was represented by Jasi Watson who assisted in the General Classification and KOM / QOM awards and all went smoothly with some rider interviews and all the winners had photos taken on the podium.

It was with much regret that following a phone call from the Chief Commissaire all of the results had to be pulled from going onto the CSA Web Site due to advice that there was an error in calculations resulting in the wrong placings given out at the presentations for General Classifications in some categories. This has never happened during the 44 years of running this Event and the Central Districts Cycling Club would like to apologise to the Under 17 Men, Under 17 Women and Under 13 as well as our major sponsor Santos.

The main two riders affected, Callum Scotson and Joshua Harrison have been contacted by myself and a special presentation will take place at the State Junior Championships on Sunday to make right an unfortunate mistake at the presentations."

South Australia's junior cycling community would like to thank all officials and volunteers and the Centrals Club for all the hard work and long hours that go into putting on this event. There is a large team at the club involved in this event but particular thanks should go to Graeme Zucker, Race Director, Marie Hedley and all her team, Ben Knobben for organising complete vehicle coverage (including lead, spares and sag vehicles in each category) and Paul King, Emergency Services Coordinator who also managed the large group of corner marshals covering the event.
