## Central Districts Cycling Club Rider Support Policy

**At the date of this policy, being 12<sup>th</sup> August 2013, the following applies:**

For a Central Districts Cycling Club (Centrals) member to receive rider support from the committee the following must be adhered to:

- \* The member must apply to the committee in writing, supply documentation that they have been selected and complete the Rider Support Application Form.
- \* The member must be willing to support a Centrals event during the year by volunteering time to help where needed (or parent(s)) as requested by the CDCC committee.
- \* The member must be willing, on return from the event, to submit a small 'story' of their experience for Centrals to publish in their newsletter and/or on their website (or with their parents help if a Junior)
- \* The member must be willing to make themselves available to have a photo taken of themselves, wearing current CDCC kit, which will be put onto the Centrals website.
- \* If the member is subjected to a Drug Test and returns a positive result (during any event in the calendar year in which they receive Rider Support money from the committee) they are to repay all monies received.

**Rider Support money to be distributed each calendar year as stipulated below:**

### 1. National Track Championships held interstate

**A maximum of \$100** to be awarded to individual Centrals members who have been selected to be part of the State Team. A **maximum 'pool' of \$500** for Junior & Senior teams combined. Payment to be made after the announcement of both teams.

The money is to be given to the member via cheque. If the member is a Junior (up to and including U19), the cheque is to be written out to one of the members' parents.

### 2. National Road Championships held interstate

**A maximum of \$100** to be awarded to individual Centrals members who have been selected to be part of the State Team. A **maximum 'pool' of \$500** for Junior & Senior teams combined. Payment to be made after the announcement of both teams.

The money is to be given to the member via cheque. If the member is a Junior (up to and including U19), the cheque is to be written out to one of the members' parents.

**\*\*** For members who have not been selected to be part of the State Team, but choose to compete, a discount of \$10 on the purchase of Centrals clothing can be applied for. Centrals clothing must be worn during the event.

## Central Districts Cycling Club Rider Support Policy

3. No amount to be awarded to Centrals members who have been selected to represent South Australia as part of the State Team for Championships held within South Australia.
4. **A maximum of \$100** to be awarded to individual Centrals members who have been selected to represent Australia as part of the Australian Team for any competitions held interstate, taking into account **a maximum 'pool' of \$500** for the calendar year. The money is to be given to the member via cheque. If the member is a Junior (up to and including U19), the cheque is to be written out to one of the members' parents. If the member receives subsidy for their expenses through sponsorship or another source, the committee can make a decision to withhold this payment.
5. No amount is to be awarded to Centrals members who have been selected to represent Australia as part of the Australian Team for any competition held within South Australia.
6. **A maximum of \$500** to be awarded to individual Centrals members who have been selected to represent Australia as part of an Australian Team for any competitions held overseas, taking into account **a maximum 'pool' of \$1000** for the calendar year. The money is to be given to the member via cheque. If the member is a Junior member (up to and including U19), the cheque is to be written out to one of the members' parents. If the member receives subsidy for their expenses through sponsorship or another source, the committee can make a decision to withhold this payment.
7. **A maximum of \$500** to be awarded to individual Centrals members within each calendar year.
8. All applications received will be looked at by the committee. The awarding of the above funds will be to the committee's discretion and may be limited by funds available to the club at the time.
9. Monetary amounts to be reviewed yearly at the Annual General Meeting.
