S.A. Rider 3rd In Vic. Cycling

Melbourne.—Dean Whitehorn (S.A.) ran third in the £310 half-mile professional race at Bendigo Showgrounds tonight. It is the richest cycling track race in Australia.

The event was won by Jack Walsh (N.S.W.) from Billy Guyatt (Vic.).

Guyatt appeared to have the race won when he entered the straight with a three lengths lead. Walsh finished powerfully to pass him when the Victorian swung wide.

Four other South Australian riders were scratched because their car broke down on the way from Adelaide. They were Phil Thomas, Jack Conyers, Keith Thurgood, and Frank Thomas.
